



# SWSSMB Stud Display Terms & Conditions Form

Current as of 16<sup>th</sup> April 2025

Please read these terms & conditions carefully. You are **REQUIRED** to sign & date below and return along with your completed application form to SWSSMB Secretary.

**Deadline for submission is 30<sup>th</sup> APRIL – no exceptions**

1. The SWS Stud Merino Breeders Field Day is an invitation only event. Studs invited to display each year are selected by the SWSSMB Committee members.
2. Deadline for submission of stud application form is 30<sup>th</sup> April. Failure to submit application form by this date will result in your position being forfeited and offered to a stud on the waiting list.
3. Invitations to displaying studs are to the owner/principal and as such are non-transferrable in the event that the stud is sold or changes ownership. In the event the stud is sold or changes ownership then a formal application is to be completed and submitted to SWSSMB Secretary.
4. Applying studs on the waiting list are considered by the SWSSMB Committee members in order of application each year.
5. Site allocation will be at the discretion of the SWSSMB Site Committee.
6. All displaying studs must be currently registered with NSW Stud Merino Breeders Association to be eligible to display.
7. Only NSW SMB registered merino sheep can be displayed, no other breeds are permitted.
8. All displaying studs must be Accredited Ovine Brucellosis Free as required for NSW SMB membership.
9. To display horns and/or polls, studs must hold the current respective registration with NSW Stud Merino Breeders Association, i.e. if the displaying stud only has horns registered, they can only display horns and likewise for polls.
10. SWSSMB Competitions are only open to displaying SWSSMB Member studs.
11. Member studs participating in The Ram of The Year competition are only able to submit one ram per site.
12. National Vendors Declarations (NVD) must be submitted to SWSSMB Secretary on or prior to event day.
13. Stud displays may be set up on Monday for event day on Tuesday. Security will be provided on the grounds overnight.
14. All studs are responsible for providing their own equipment & displays.
15. SWSSMB accepts no responsibility for loss or damage by participating studs.
16. Studs are requested to ensure their display is fully set up and all vehicles moved to the allocated parking area by 9am on Tuesday morning.
17. Allocated display sites must be cleaned up at the end of the day including any straw used. Failure to do so will result in no invitation to return next year.
