

Market Stallholder Terms & Conditions

The following Terms & Conditions apply to all market stallholders invited to participate in the SWS Stud Merino Breeders (SWSSMB) Field Day. Submission of a stallholder application form constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

1. Invitation-Only Participation

The SWSSMB Field Day is an invitation-only event. Market stallholders are selected annually at the discretion of the SWSSMB Committee.

2. Application Deadline

Completed stallholder application forms must be submitted by **30 June**. Failure to submit by this date will result in forfeiture of your position, which may be offered to a stallholder on the waiting list.

3. Non-Transferability of Invitations

Invitations are issued to the stallholder/business owner and are **non-transferable**. If the business is sold or changes ownership, a new formal application must be submitted to the SWSSMB Secretary for consideration.

4. Site Allocation

Stall sites will be allocated solely at the discretion of the SWSSMB Site Committee. While preferences may be noted, placement cannot be guaranteed.

5. Insurance Requirements

All stallholders must hold current **Public & Product Liability Insurance** and provide a valid certificate of currency with their registration.

6. Liability

SWSSMB accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage, theft, or injury incurred by stallholders, their staff, or their property while participating in the event.

7. Set Up Access

Stallholders may set up their stalls on **Monday** prior to the event. Overnight security will be present on the grounds.

8. Event-Day Set-Up Procedure

Stallholders setting up on **Tuesday morning** must:

- Unload their vehicle at their allocated site
- Immediately move the vehicle to the designated parking area
- Complete stall setup after parking All vehicles must be parked by **9:00am**.

9. Stallholder Equipment

Stallholders are responsible for supplying all required equipment, including tables, marquees, display items, power cords, and weather protection.

10. Zero-Waste Commitment

This is a **zero-waste event**. Stallholders are encouraged to use compostable and recyclable packaging, products, and containers wherever possible.

11. Site Clean-Up

All stall sites must be left clean, tidy, and free of waste at the conclusion of the event. Failure to do so may result in the stallholder not being invited to return the following year.
